

Nebraska MCC Relief Sale Board Members Job Description

Each church shall periodically appoint one church member to serve as a representative to the Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale Board of Directors. The term shall be a three-year term, renewable one time. The board member shall not serve for more than six years during one consecutive time. Any vacancy occurring by death or resignation in the Board of Directors will be filled by the board and shall be elected for the unexpired term of his predecessor in office.

The duties of the board member shall include, but not limited to the following:

- Be committed to the cause of the Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale. . Attend all meetings of the board.
- Encourage contact couples to explain the sale to the congregation as needed.
- Be willing to express your ideas in a creative and thoughtful manner at board meetings.
- Promote the entire sale.
- Help make decisions that are brought to the board.
- Help during the Relief Sale as assigned by the board.

The board of Directors of the Nebraska Mennonite Relief Sale will elect from the group their officers for one year term. The director shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board of Directors. The number of directors shall be not less than twelve and not more than sixteen.

It is expected that each board member will attend all regular meetings and special meetings of the Board of directors. There will be no compensation received for services by anyone serving on the board.
